Masked “Singer” Project

Overview: Students will record themselves performing a song or small section of a song. Recordings will be done and submitted on Flipgrid. By applying stickers to their video, they will create sticker scenes that disguise their identity. The class then has to guess who is who. *This project is doable by any music class. Masked Bandie, Masked Stringer, Masked Singer, Masked Orffer, etc

Step 1

*Students prepare and practice a piece of choice or assignment from their teacher.

Step 2

*Teacher needs to set up a group in Flipgrid, taking care to make sure to use only school domain as the accepted email addresses in order to protect student privacy.

*Teacher shares the group code to join in their LMS of choice (Google Classroom, Schoology, etc)

Step 3

*Once group is created, the teacher needs to create a topic (assignment) with the following settings: Choose appropriate timing, click on the settings gear icon, set to moderate videos and comments, set comments to none, toggle OFF all options under “response”, toggle ON all options under camera, then click POST TOPIC.

Step 4

*Students then record their performance by clicking on the green plus sign. Videos are editable directly within the app. Once they have recorded, they are going to add backgrounds, stickers, etc. When saving and titling their recording they should choose their STAGE NAME.

Step 5

*Teacher needs to add each video into a mixtape on Flipgrid. This allows then to be viewed by anyone, but also does not divulge the identity. It also allows for easy sharing whether the teacher is in person or remote.

Step 6

*Students write down the stage name and guess the classmates names.

*Have a reveal party! I gave out prizes for most creative name, most creative sticker scene, fooled the most people, etc. Make sure to not just reward talent/perfection. Be inclusive, and be fun!
